## Eight Easy steps to Successful Recycling.

**D**ecide to recycle and start saving money! It only takes eight easy steps to get started with Allied Waste's single-stream recycling program:

- 1. Designate a "Recycling Coordinator":** Select someone to oversee your recycling program. Your Recycling Coordinator is responsible for arranging recycling collection, encouraging employees/residents and overall program monitoring.
- 2. Call Allied Waste's Commercial Recycling Coordinator at 650-756-1130** for assistance in getting your program started.
- 3. Get recycling bins.** Allied Waste Services provides outdoor recycling containers and carts (which can be used indoors if space allows) beginning in early 2007. You will need to purchase indoor recycling containers for collection then transfer the contents to the Allied Waste container for collection. Other options:
  - **Businesses can take advantage of FREE desk-side recycling boxes from Allied Waste Services.**
  - **Multi-family customers should encourage residents to separate recyclables from trash using paper or #4 plastic bags as storage, then transfer full bags to the recycling container.**
- 4. Identify recyclable items.** Educate your employees/residents on the various beverage containers in the CRV (California Redemption Value) program. This includes glass and plastics! **See Allied Waste's expanded list of accepted recyclables under "Save the Date!"**
- 5. Location, Location, Location.** Be sure to place recycling bins in convenient central areas. For restaurants, try a kitchen corner. For offices, try next to copiers, routing/mail boxes and employee breakrooms. For multi-family dwellings, try placing containers right next to the trash containers.
- 6. Make it Easy.** Post Allied Waste provided fact sheets and flyers indicating accepted materials. Additionally, a detailed recycling sticker is affixed to every recycling cart and container. Desk-side boxes also include the list.
- 7. Kick-off the Recycling Program.** Announce your new recycling program at staff meetings or on a bulletin board.
  - **Keep Up the Enthusiasm. Create employee/resident recycling incentive programs to keep the momentum going. Here are some simple ideas to keep everyone engaged in recycling:**
    - Reward yourselves for recycling and have a quarterly party. If you saved money as a result of recycling you can use some of these funds!
    - Recognize employees/residents who reduce waste— "Recycler of the Month."
- 8. Let your customers/future residents know you run a recycling-friendly establishment**

### How "Single Stream Recycling" works:

- You'll have the choice of a 68 or 95-gallon blue recycling cart or a larger, green container ranging in size from 1-6 cubic yards. No source-separating is necessary— all accepted materials are collected in the same container.
- An Allied Waste Services recycling coordinator will work with you to determine the appropriate sized recycling container/number of service days for your business or multi-family community. A free, walk-through audit will help you find everything recyclable!
- Free, desk-side boxes are available to Allied Waste commercial customers. All single stream recycling customers receive fact sheets and posters educating your staff or residents how to properly recycle.

### This program accepts:

- Newspapers, Magazines, Office Paper and Mixed Paper
- Junk mail, cereal and dry food boxes, catalogs, phone books, paper bags, packaging, white and colored paper, paperback books, file folders and envelopes
- Rinsed, coated milk and juice cartons
- Plastic containers labeled 1 - 7
- Aluminum and Tin Cans
- Glass Containers (clear, brown, green)
- Flattened Cardboard
- Plastic Bags, Bread Bags and Clean, Frozen Food Bags (labeled #4 plastic)

### Sorry, the following are not accepted:

- Food and food waste left in containers
- Shrink and soft wrap, molded Styrofoam
- "Peanuts" packaging material and loose bubble wrap
- Restroom waste papers
- Glass panels and fluorescent light bulbs
- Hazardous materials (computer and TV monitors, chemicals, paint)
- Waxed cardboard
